**A RESOLUTION OF PORT ROYAL BOROUGH COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE
PENNSYLVANIA STATE ASSOCIATION OF BOROUGH
JUNIOR COUNCIL PERSON PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Port Royal Borough Council seeks to educate and involve the Youth of the Borough in their local government, and to reach out to involve possible future members of Council, to benefit both the youth and all residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Junior Council Person (JCP) Program as established and fostered by the Pennsylvania State Association of Boroughs (PSAB), seeks to encourage Boroughs to have high school or college age Borough residents participate in the workings of their local government by appointing Junior Council Person(s); and

WHEREAS, Borough Council intends to seek assistance from High School or College faculty members and guidance counselors to recommend prospective Junior Council candidates to Council, and Council plans to select a student to serve as Junior Council Person during the school year; and



WHEREAS, the Council wishes to extend to the youth of Port Royal Borough a voice in the operation of this Borough and this Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1) The Council of the Borough of Port Royal hereby creates the position of "Junior Council Person."
- 2) The term of office shall be during the student's school year.
- 3) Candidates for the office shall submit a written application to Borough Council with a one-Page cover letter highlighting the applicant's interest in the position. After considering all submissions, Borough Council shall appoint student(s) at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- 4) The Junior Council Person shall be a Borough resident and a high school or college student.
- 5) The Junior Council Person shall, upon appointment, take a "Junior Council Person Pledge."
- 6) The Junior Council Person shall not receive compensation.
- 7) The Junior Council Person shall be permitted to attend all meetings of Council and all Committee meetings and shall be permitted to participate fully in those proceedings, **EXCEPT** that he/she shall not be afforded the right to vote and shall not be permitted to attend executive sessions.

Resolution No. 2020-August 10
Port Royal Borough, Juniata County, Pennsylvania

WHEREAS, **Port Royal Borough**, Juniata County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, **Port Royal Borough** acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the Juniata County 2020 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Juniata County Commissioners and the Juniata County Department of Emergency Services in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of **Port Royal Borough**, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Juniata County 2020 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and


WHEREAS, the Juniata County 2020 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the **Port Royal Borough**:




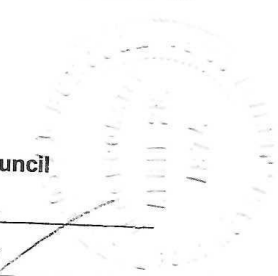

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-11-9

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PORT ROYAL, JUNIATA COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Port Royal Borough, Juniata County, Pennsylvania:

THAT a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all real property within Port Royal Borough subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2021 as follows:

SECTION 1. Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 10 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of (.010) cents on each one hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$100.00) of assessed valuation.


SECTION 2. The rate for the purpose of making appropriations to fire companies, the sum of 1 mill on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of (.001) cents on each one hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$100.00) dollars of assessed valuation.


SECTION 3. All other municipal tax rates are to remain unchanged.

SECTION 4. That any resolution, or part of resolution, conflicting with this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this resolution.




